

## **Thanksgiving**

The 2011 Thanksgiving Mobilization begins November 14<sup>th</sup> and runs through November 27<sup>th</sup>.

Participation in this campaign involves just three simple steps that give your agency a chance to win enforcement equipment!

- 1. Sign up**
- 2. Conduct your agency's enforcement details during the two-week period**
- 3. Report the results of your enforcement details to IDOT's Division of Traffic Safety (form will be sent to you after signing up). The data sheet must be turned in by **December 5, 2011**.**

Once the report is received, your agency will be placed in a drawing for valuable enforcement equipment (moving radars, hand-held radars and lidars).

All that is required to be eligible for the drawing is enforcement activity in at least one of the following citation categories:

- DUI arrest
- Under-21, zero-tolerance arrest
- Safety belt or child passenger safety citation written between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.

### **Christmas/New Years**

The 2011 Christmas/New Years Mobilization begins December 19, 2011 and runs through January 1, 2012.

Participation in this campaign involves just three simple steps that give your agency a chance to win enforcement equipment!

- 1. Sign up**
- 2. Conduct your agency's enforcement details during the two-week period**
- 3. Report the results of your enforcement details to IDOT's Division of Traffic Safety (form will be sent to you after signing up). The data sheet must be turned in by **January 9, 2012**.**

Once the report is received, your agency will be placed in a drawing for valuable enforcement equipment (moving radars, hand-held radars, portable breath testers and lidars).

All that is required to be eligible for the drawing is enforcement activity in at least one of the following citation categories:

- DUI arrest
- Under-21, zero-tolerance arrest
- Safety belt or child passenger safety citation written between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.

## **Memorial Day**

The 2012 Memorial Day *Click It or Ticket* Mobilization begins May 11, 2012 and runs through May 28, 2012.

First prize: \$25,000 in enforcement equipment!

**The Memorial Day holiday incentive program is a bit different from the others in three ways:** 1. Awards are much larger; 2. Awards are given based on productivity. Your agency will only be competing against departments of comparable size (the size is determined by the number of Sworn Officers you report on your data sheet); and 3. Grantees compete for additional funds and non-funded agencies compete for equipment.

Participation in this campaign involves just three simple steps that give your agency a chance to win enforcement equipment!

- 1. Sign up**
- 2. Conduct your agency's enforcement details during the two-week period**
- 3. Report the results of your enforcement details to IDOT's Division of Traffic Safety (form will be sent to you after signing up). The data sheet must be turned in by **June 4, 2012**.**

Your agency's productivity will be measured based on citations' issued in the following categories:

- Safety Belt Citations
- Child Passenger Safety Citations
- Safety Belt Enforcement Zones

## **July 4<sup>th</sup>**

The 2012 July 4<sup>th</sup> Mobilization begins June 22, 2012 and runs through July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2012.

Participation in this campaign involves just three simple steps that give your agency a chance to win enforcement equipment!

- 1. Sign up**
- 2. Conduct your agency's enforcement details during the two-week period**
- 3. Report the results of your enforcement details to IDOT's Division of Traffic Safety (form will be sent to you after signing up). The data sheet must be turned in by **July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2012.****

Once the report is received, your agency will be placed in a drawing for valuable enforcement equipment.

All that is required to be eligible for the drawing is enforcement activity in at least one of the following citation categories:

- DUI arrest
- Under-21, zero-tolerance arrest
- Safety belt or child passenger safety citation written between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.

### **Labor Day**

The 2012 Labor Day *You Drink & Drive. You Lose*. Mobilization begins August 17, 2012 and runs through September 3, 2012.

Participation in this campaign involves just three simple steps that give your agency a chance to win enforcement equipment!

- 1. Sign up**
- 2. Conduct your agency's enforcement details during the two-week period**
- 3. Report the results of your enforcement details to IDOT's Division of Traffic Safety (form will be sent to you after signing up). The data sheet must be turned in by **September 10, 2012.****

Once the report is received, your agency will be placed in a drawing for valuable enforcement equipment.

All that is required to be eligible for the drawing is enforcement activity in at least one of the following citation categories:

- DUI arrest
- Under-21, zero-tolerance arrest
- Safety belt or child passenger safety citation written between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
